

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2015/16

To support pupils at Toft Hill Primary School all PE funding was targeted at:

- To improve expertise and confidence of staff by providing appropriate training
- To fund employment of PE apprentice to help provide effective teaching of PE and curriculum support
- To raise profile of PE in the school and increase intra school competitions
- To improve resources for Gymnastics so it can be taught effectively
- To fund transport for pupils to attend inter school competitions
- To raise subject leader's knowledge

Measuring the impact of PE spending

- Teachers attending increased number of CPD opportunities from previous year. Impact seen during monitoring of lessons.
- High level of pupil participation at after school clubs.
- Increased level of participation at Level 2 School games events and cluster festivals. 100% of pupils from Years 6, 5, 4, 2, 1 and Reception pupils attended at least one event.
- Over 75% of pupils who attended Change 4 Life club attended further after school opportunities.
- KS2 pupils engaged in leading, managing and officiating Level 1 intra school games.
